For admission to the DNS Programme January 2018 batch, the Common Entrance Test (CET) will be conducted on **Saturday, 16th December 2017**. This CET will be applicable only to sponsored candidates of Affiliated Institutes. The notification for the CET will be published in IMU's website around first week of November 2017 and the Online Application will go live on 15th November 2017.

All the Affiliated Institutes conducting DNS Programme January 2018 Batch have to make necessary tie-ups for onboard training for the candidates to be admitted, with Ship-Owning Companies / Ship managing Companies/RSPL agencies before the above mentioned date. The number of slots for which the sponsorship is available should be forwarded to IMU on or before Friday 10th November 2017 in the format prescribed on the Official Letter Head signed by the Authorised Signatory as per Annexure - I.

The Affiliated Institute should acquire the necessary sponsorship letters from the Ship-owning Companies / Ship-managing Companies/ RPSL Agencies on the Official Letter Head of the Sponsoring Company/ Agency duly signed by the authorized signatory, indicating the number of seats sponsored for that particular Institute. They should send photocopies of the sponsorship letters to the Controller of Examinations, Indian Maritime University, Chennai along with scanned copies of the sponsorship letters at coe@imu.ac.in. No Affiliated Institute should make any admissions to DNS Programme without first obtaining these sponsorship letters.

CET for the January 2018 DNS leading to B.Sc. (Applied Nautical Science) batch will be conducted in the following manner: -

- i) The subjects for the CET for DNS January 2018 batch shall be for 100 marks for 100 questions for the following four subjects - 1. Physics - 25 marks 2. Chemistry - 25 marks 3. Mathematics - 25 marks and 4. English - 25 marks at Plus 2 level (CBSE, ISE and State Boards).
- ii) Test will be conducted in only the 6 IMU Campuses Chennai, Kolkata, Navi Mumbai, Mumbai Port, Cochin and Visakhapatnam. The CET will be in pen and paper mode, using OMR Sheets.

Only candidates who have passed the CET, and who fulfil the eligibility criteria relating to age, educational qualifications, medical fitness etc. as per IMU norms shall be eligible for admission to DNS January 2018 batch.
